As I am sure that you are now aware, the Coronavirus (Covid 19) has been declared a global pandemic. At Manchester Organics our top priority is the health and safety of our employees, their families and the bigger communities who we all may encounter. We are therefore committed to working with our employees to ensure that, in line with the UK Governmental advice, we continue to run our business with a responsible approach.

In line with the most recent UK Governmental advice issued on the 16th March 2020 we are now implementing, that where possible, our members of staff will work remotely. This is something that has been tried and tested over the past 24 – 48 hours and we therefore do not envisage that there will be any reduction in our services. Where remote working is not feasible, we are working with our employees to ensure that their health and safety is of upmost importance. Our QC laboratory, despatch, and production departments are still open and running as usual and we are continuing to manufacture and despatch our customer requirements on a daily basis. Where possible we have put protocols in place to help minimise social contact and we have also implemented other protocol for breaks and lunch periods to help reduce the chances of the virus spreading. At this time, all our staff members are healthy and well. We are doing everything we can to continue this approach.

To ensure the safety of our staff and the wider public we have also taken the decision to stop all international and domestic business travel and we will not be accepting visitors onsite at Manchester Organics until further notice. If you do need to discuss matters with us, we can arrange for conference calls to be set up to accommodate this.

We are continuing to follow the UK Governmental advice that is being updated daily and we will look at amending our working environments for our employees in line with this.
